When Belco XT Post has been designed for use in an uplift application, post bases and caps are REQUIRED. Belco recommends Simpson Strong Tie products but products of equal properties are accepted. Refer to base and cap manufacturer's instructions for capacities and connector attachment.







BELCO XT® PRESERVATIVE TREATED PRODUCTS

- BATTEN Narrow strips of wood used to cover joints or as decorative vertical members over plywood or wide boards. Typically 1x2, 1x3
- BALUSTER / RAIL Vertical and horizontal members in a balustrade. Typically 2x2, 2x4
- BARGEBOARD Exterior house trim along a gable. Typically 2x8
- BELLY BAND The nontechnical term for decorative cladding that runs horizontally around a house or building. It usually runs around the building at about the height of the first or second floor. Typically 2x10, 2x12
- CORNER TRIM Decorative trim to help protect the corners where siding joints come together. Typically 5/4x3, 5/4x4

- N DRIP EDGE Trim strip under the roof edge installed on fascia and bargeboard (gable end fascia) to protect against moisture intrusion. Typically 1x2
- FASCIA Horizontal boards attached to rafter/truss ends at the eaves and along gables. Typically 2x8
- ♠ FRIEZE/RAKE Trim member connecting the siding with the soffit. Typically 1x4
- ▶ POST Structural column for porches and decks. Typically 6x6
- WINDOW TRIM AND WINDOW SILL Decorative trim elements for windows and doors. Typically 2x3 (sill), 1x3 (trim)
- SOFFIT A decorative covering consisting of interlocked T&G boards to add depth and texture to exterior ceilings and overhangs. Typically 1x2, 1x3


